COMPLETION REPORT

- 6/15/82 Rig up Mack Chase completion unit.
- 6/16/82 Rig up Gearhart. Perforate 1948-53, 1909-14 w/one shot per foot. Rig up Halliburton. Acidized with 2,000 gallons 20% NEFe acid. Balled out. Flow and swab back. No show of oil.
- 6/17/82 Rig up Halliburton. Acidize with 6,000 gallons of 20% NEFe acid. Dropped eight balls. Flow back. Show of oil after 45 minutes flow.
- 6/18/82 Swab-load back. Show of oil.
- 6/19/82 Swab. Well making about 70 gallons oil and two barrels water per hour. Release rig.
- 6/22/82 Rig up Mack Chase swab unit.
- 6/23/82 Swab well down.
- 6/23/82 Swab. Well stabilized at 15-17 gallons oil and approximately 50
to 7/2/82 gallons water per hour. Some gas. Water analysis on last day indicated San Andres water.
- 7/14/82 Set pumping unit and test tank. After pumping off accumulated fluid for three days, the well stabilized at 1 BOPD and 7 BWPD (no gas). However, the oil is still declining. On 7/23/82 it made about 20 gallons of oil and 10-12 barrels water.
