

SDX Resources, Inc., P.O. Box 5061, Midland, Texas 79704, has filed form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval for injection wells. The proposed injection zone for the "Leonard Fed. #3" located 1980' FNL & 1980' FWL of Section 33, Township 17 South, Range 29 East of Eddy County, New Mexico, is the Grayburg and San Andres formations with perforations from 2654' to 2956'. The proposed injection zone for the "Leonard B. Fed. #1" located 330' FNL & 1650' FEL of Section 33, Township 17 South, Range 29 East of Eddy County, New Mexico, is the Grayburg and San Andres formations with perforations from 2650' to 3048'. SDX Resources, Inc. intends to inject a maximum of 1000 bbls of produced formation water per day at a maximum of 530 psi.
