OIL OR GAS SANDS OR ZONES

February 14, 1958. In lowering a 275 lb solidified shot, part
dipped and part in 5" shells. The largest dump bucket hung at 800',
and in trying to loosen same it was dumped at that depth. In order
to get the shot on down it was necessary to swab out the oil. Then
675' was swabbed near 1500'. The shot was settled on to bottom,
rest of shot was run and hole is filled with oil. 6' of shot gravel
was put on top of shot and 26' of gravel set on top of gravel.
Then shot exploded causing some damage to the derrick that was
left in the thread (below where well was stopped), exploded and
damaged pipe from 1450' to 1667', rest of 7" including shoe was
undamaged. Pipe was cemented above 1450' and no mud was released
back of 7". This pipe was washed out to full size and the hole is
in good condition to be deepened or stopped.

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "saddled", or left in the well, give its size and location. If the well has been dynamited, give date, size, position, and number of shots. If plugs or bridges were put in to test for water, state kind of material used, position, and results of pumping or bailing or shots.
