DETAILS OF WORK

On May 13, 1962 we ran 414' of 10 3/4" OD 8rd 32.75# used H3 casing to 414' and obtained formation shut-off. No surface water, this casing was run to shut-off dry save.

On May 20, 1962 we ran 1485' of 8 5/8" OD 8rd 24# new J2 casing to 1485' and obtained formation shut-off. Shut-off was verified by bailing hole dry and testing for 1 hour.

Note: Both of the above strings of casing were subsequently pulled during cementing operations on 7" OD casing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
