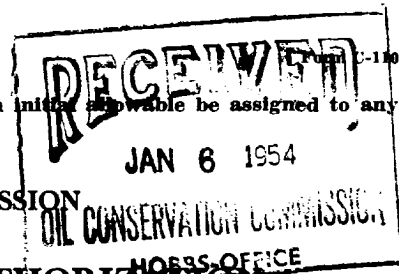


It is necessary that Form C-104 be approved before this form can be approved and an initial allowable be assigned to any completed oil or gas well.
