1. Moved in and rigged up workover unit, pulled rods and tubing.
2. Ran Correlation Log.
3. Perforated 3-1/2" casing with one shot per interval at the following depths:  
3234', 3248', 3252', 3257', 3271', 3277', 3287', 3294', 3312', 3321', 3371',  
3386', 3409', 3593', 3602', 3611', a total of 16' and 16 shots.
4. Set packer at 3588' and retrievable bridge plug at 3630' and treated 3-1/2" casing perforations 3593-3611' with 500 gallons regular 15% acid.
5. Set packer at 3157' and retrievable bridge plug at 3450' and treated 3-1/2" casing perforations 3234-3409' with 1,000 gallons regular 15% acid.
6. Pulled tubing and packer and treated down 3-1/2" casing into perforations 3234-3409' with 15,000 20/40 sand and 15,000 gallons "Click" water.
7. Pulled retrievable bridge plug at 3450'.
8. Ran 2-3/8" tubing, rods and pump. Pumped and tested.
9. Well returned to production status April 10, 1967.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
