**DETAILS OF WORK**

Well is producing from Grayburg Jackson as previously reported on Form 9-331 A, producing approximately 1 barrel per day. As the operators of this lease the following information was obtained from a true set of well records. Mr. Weier and Mr. R.C. Brandon previously operated this lease, now both are deceased as of November, 1962. Consequently we had to take over the operations of the Lease due to their demise and we are not well acquainted with all of the wells or the procedures with which they conducted their business. We find that 4 1/2" casing is set @ 2862', cemented by Halliburton method and well produces from this production zone, being the Grayburg - Jackson, erroneously reported as the Fren production zone.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
