Well was deepened from 2014' to 3128', 5 1/2" pipe was set at 3056 feet cemented with 65 sacks of cement. The premier sand was encountered at 3115' and the well flowed natural about 70 barrels per day during the time that drilling was continued, tubing has now been run to 3033' and the well is on production.
