Gentlemen:

The January, 1965, closing stock for our Dow "B" Well No. 39, Fren Paddock Pool was 82 barrels.

We have recompleted our Dow "B" Well No. 39 in the Grayburg and San Andres zone of the Grayburg Jackson Pool during the month of January, 1965. The tank battery which was used for Fren Paddock Pool production is now needed for Grayburg and San Andres production. The Paddock zone of our Dow "B" Well No. 39 has been squeezed and will no longer produce into this battery.

We are requesting authority to commingle this 82 barrels of Paddock oil with Grayburg and San Andres production in order to run the oil.
