Located 990 feet from South line and 660 feet from East line of Section 24, 17 South, 30 East, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson Field\*, Eddy County, New Mexico

Subsequent Report of Water Shut-Off - Details of Work

Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 7,090 feet rotary bushing measurement; ran 7,090 feet of 11.6# 4-1/2" seamless casing with float shoe on bottom and D. V. tool (packer type) spaced at 6,869 feet with 29 roto wall cleaners (141 feet) and 8 S-3 centralizers spaced from bottom up above D. V. tool.

First Stage Cement: 75 sacks of cement with 70 gallons LA2 was displaced around shoe with plug and D. V. tool opened. Estimated 9 sacks cement were circulated into pits. Cement set 9 hours.

Second Stage Cement: Calculated amount cement to circulate to surface was 821 sacks. Casing was cemented by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company using 800 sacks 50-50 Incor Pozmix 6% Gel added, followed by 50 sacks neat cement. After cement was displaced into annulus, D. V. tool was closed. Final plug on bottom 1:00 A.M. 3/16/63. Cement did not circulate. Total amount of cement used both stages 925 sacks.

Cement was allowed to set 96 hours.

Per verbal agreement between E. R. McPhaul of Nash, Windfohr and Brown and Mr. Brown of the U.S.G.S. office at Artesia on 3/15/63

NOTE: The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission has designated that Jackson 25-B is located in the Grayburg Jackson Field.
