DETAILS OF WORK

8/21/65

8/23/65 - From PL 6955, reperf. old perfs. 6924-32 & 6925-6900, 02, 06, 08, 10, 12, 14, 16, 20, 22 using Schlumberger casing gun, 2 holes per interval perforated (total 32 holes). Acidized 1000 gal 18% plus 15 ball sealers to break down new perfs. Treated @ 1600 psi until balls hit, increased to 2300 (3/4 WPM inj. rate), increased press. 3000 (inj. rate increased 1 1/2 WPM), 3 minute shut-in 3000. In 12 hrs., swab back total load of 31 D.O. and 24 lbs plus 44 balls, fluid (18% NO + 82% fur. water). Shut well in 8/23/65 waiting on orders. Probably install pumping unit in near future.
