Enclosed please find the copies of Form C-105 which you recently submitted for the subject well. They are being returned so that you may complete the back side of the form as required. Further, this office has received your request, on Form C-103 to continue to carry this well as Temporarily Abandoned. However, we feel that this well should not remain indefinitely temporarily abandoned in its present condition. Therefore, Form C-103 must be filed, immediately, requesting continued temporary abandonment for a period not to exceed 90 days or, outlining a plugging program or, outlining a program to run production casing or drill deeper.
