SURFACE USE CHECK LIST

GENERAL AMERICAN'S PROPOSED GREEN "A" # 3

Section 29, Township 17-S, Range 29-E

Eddy County, New Mexico

- 1. Existing roads are shown on Exhibit "A".
- 2. Planned access roads will require only about 660' of new construction. The new road and location will be surfaced with caliche.
- 3. Location of existing wells are shown on Exhibit "B".
- 4. Lateral roads to well locations are shown on Exhibit "A".
- 5. There is only one current tank battery within a half-a-mile radius of the proposed well and it is located 2310' from south and 330' from east lines in Section 29, Township 17-S, Range 29-E. If production is obtained on this well the tank battery will be constructed on the drilling pad. Gas line route would depend on the purchaser.
- 6. Water supply to drill this well will be furnished through the water line shown on Exhibit "C". The water line is already in existence and will require no construction except for 1300' of lateral line to be laid on top of the ground to the well. If brine water is needed in drilling this well it will be trucked.
- 7. Waste disposal will be handled by appropriate approved means at such times as it becomes necessary.
- 8. No camps are planned.
- 9. No airstrips will be constructed.
- 10. Locations and layout including position of the rig, mud tanks, reserve pits, pipe rack, etc. are shown on Exhibit "D".
- 11. All pits used for drilling will be levelled back to their natural contours after they have dried.
- 12. The general topography of the drill site is flat with a few sand dunes. The vegetation is made up of mesquite, weeds and a small amount of grass.
