

SURFACE USE CHECK LIST

GENERAL AMERICAN'S PROPOSED ARNOLD "E" #10

SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 17-S, RANGE 29-E

EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

1. Existing main roads are shown on Exhibit "A".
2. Planned access road will require about 1900' of scraping out mostly of an old road and only a few spots should have to be surfaced with caliche. The location will be surfaced with caliche.
3. Location of existing wells are shown on Exhibit "B".
4. Lateral roads to well locations are shown on Exhibit "B".
5. The proposed tank battery will be built on the drilling pad. Other tank batteries in the immediate area are shown on Exhibit "C".
6. Water supply to drill this well will be furnished through a 1400' water line laid on top of the ground shown on Exhibit "C". Additional water will be trucked.
7. Waste disposal will be handled by appropriate approved means at such times as it becomes necessary.
8. No Camps are planned.
9. No Airstrips will be constructed.
10. Location and layout including position of the rig, mud tanks, reserve pits, pipe rack, etc. are shown on Exhibit "D".
11. All pits used for drilling will be leveled back to their natural contours after they have dried.
