THE APPLICATION OF I & W INC.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), I & W, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 13, 1987, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Walter Solt State No. 1 well located in Unit L of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
- (3) That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.
- (4) That no objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, I & W Inc. is hereby authorized to complete its Walter Solt State Well No. 1, located in Unit L of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 28 Rast, IMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Wolfcamp formation at approximately 7518 feet to approximately 7812 feet through 2 7/8 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 7500 feet.
