AMENDED Administrative Order NSL-4095

Dear Ms. Byers:

In reviewing the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") files on pending matters in Santa Fe, an application for an unorthodox oil well location dated April 22, 1998 was discovered for Devon Energy Corporation's ("Devon") Turner "B" Well No. 115 to be drilled 1050 feet from the North line and 25 Feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. Further research into this matter shows that Administrative Order NSL-4095, dated July 16, 1998, was issued for Devon's Turner "A" Well No. 61 identified as API No. 30-015-30211 to be drilled 1050 feet from the North line and 25 Feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Our well files indicate that Devon originally filed an "Authorization for Permit to Drill" ("APD") on the Turner "B" Well No. 115 in April, 1998. This well was subsequently assigned API No. 30-015-30211. In May, 1998 a sundry notice was filed showing a well name and location change from Turner "B" Well No. 115 in Section 20 to the Turner "A" Well No. 61 in Section 19, the assigned API remained the same. In July, 1998 NSL-4095 was issued. In November, 1998 another sundry notice was filed, which showed a second well name and location change. The Turner "A" Well No. 61 in Section 19 was changed back to the Turner "B" Well No. 115 in Section 20. Our records do not indicate that the requested location in Section 19 was ever drilled.

At this time Division Administrative Order NSL-4095 should be amended to accurately reflect the correct well and location.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F (2) the application of Devon for its Turner "B" Well No. 115 (API No. 30-015-30211), located at an unorthodox infill oil well location 1050 feet from the North line and 25 Feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, is hereby approved. This well is to be dedicated to the existing 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 20.

This amended order shall supersede the previous order issued on July 16, 1998.

Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
