DETAILS OF WORK

This well has been plugged back to a total depth of 2800 feet.
 4-1/2" casing was cut off at 1710 feet. We plan to run log to a total depth of 2240 feet, perforate approximately twenty feet in the San Andres formation from 2175 to 2195 feet, using three shots per foot, water frack with 60,000 pounds of sand through 4-1/2" casing set on packer at approximately 1715 feet.

Contractor is Carl Howell, Artesia, New Mexico. Cementing and logging work to be done by Welox and Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
