REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE ORGANIZATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

CHAPTER I

THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

The Federal Government is a complex organization with many departments and agencies. It is responsible for the national defense, foreign relations, and the general welfare of the people.

The Commission has studied the organization and administration of the Federal Government and has found many areas for improvement.

The Commission has found that the Federal Government is too large and too complex. It has many overlapping agencies and departments.

The Commission has found that the Federal Government is too expensive. It spends too much money on its operations.

The Commission has found that the Federal Government is too slow. It takes too long to make decisions and to carry out its programs.

The Commission has found that the Federal Government is too unaccountable. It is not clear who is responsible for its actions.

The Commission has found that the Federal Government is too inflexible. It does not respond quickly to the needs of the people.
