HISTORY OF OIL OR GAS WELL

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked" or left in the well, give its size and location. If the well has been dynamited, give date, size, position, and number of shots. If plugs or bridges were put in to test for water, state kind of material used, position, and results of pumping or bailing.

This well was commenced 11-8-59 and a 10" hole was drilled to 735', New 8 5/8", 24#, J-55 casing was set at 734' and cemented with 50 sacks of regular cement w/2% calcium chloride on 11-13-59. Waited on cement 24 hours and bailed hole dry, drilled plug and bailed dry. Drilled 20 ft. into salt and encountered salt water. Drilled 8" hole to 1817' and set 7" casing. Drilled 6" hole to 3200'. (Oil shows are listed above). Reached T. D. 12-20-59. Started plugging well 12-21-59 - 75' plug at 3200', 75' plug @ 2470 - 2500'. WOC 24 hrs. Pulled 7" casing and set 100' plug at Base of 8 5/8" casing. Left 7 fts. of 8 5/8" in hole (195'). 50 ft. plug @ Stub and placed regulation marker @ surface with 5 sacks. P & A 12-23-59
