1. Rigged up pulling unit, pulled rods and tubing.
2. Cleaned out with reverse unit from 2640' to 2663'.
3. Perforated additional Grayburg Zones as follows:
Metex - 2424-28, 2462-67, 2480-84, 2492-96 @ 2 SPF.
Premier - 2584-90, 2596-2602, 2616-20, 2624-29 and 2632-37 @ 2 SPF.
Note: Old perfs - Metex - 2463, 2465 & 2482 - 1 shot each interval.
Premier - 2578, 2580, 2584, 2614, 2616 & 2624 - 1 shot each interval.
4. Acidized all Metex and Premier perfs with a total of 50 barrels of 15% NE acid and flushed with 120 barrels of fresh water.
5. Ran 2 3/8" tubing with S. N. set open-ended @ 2635', ran rods and pump and returned well to production.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL, IF ANY:

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
