February 14, 1951: At 4:00 P. M., 48 Hours after being cemented, the 8-5/8" casing at 345' was tested for shut off. Top of cement was found at 339' inside of pipe. Casing test made after bailing dry and allowing to stand 3 hours. No fluid entered. Cement plug drilled to 349' and bailed dry. Stood 3 hours for test and no fluid entered. Casing test and water shut-off test considered satisfactory. Drilling ahead.
