Dear Sir:

There seems to have been some misunderstanding among the various interested parties who have reworked the above mentioned well with regard to the running and cementing of the production string of casing as set out in your Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Recomplete, and approved by me on June 20, 1956.

The 5½" casing has been run to 3251' and cemented with 70 sacks of cement, which does not protect the fresh water strata between 600 and 700 feet. In this regard, please refer to my letter of May 7, 1956, to Mr. Claude G. Hall.

I have approved your Form C-110 and Form C-104, Request for Oil Allowable, for a 30-day testing period beginning June 27, 1956, with a proviso that after the 30 days the 5½" casing will be perforated at the top of the salt and squeeze with cement to the surface, and notify this office when this work will start in order that we may be present to witness the job.
