Notified BLM (Adam Salameh) - Plugged & Abandoned as follows:

- 9-18-93 Set a cement retainer at 2425' to isolate perforations from 2485' to 2506'. Stung into retainer. Pumped 30 sx of Class "C" cement into perforations. Obtained squeeze at 1800 PSI. Pulled out of retainer and pumped 20 sx on top of retainer. Perforated 4 holes at 800'. Pumped 30 sx of Class "C" cement into perforations to obtain 50' inside and 50' outside the 5 1/2" casing.
- 9-19-93 Tagged top of cement at 700'. Perforated 4 holes at 220'. Pumped 50 sx of Class "C" cement between 5 1/2" and 8 5/8" casing. Shut 8 5/8" casing valve and pumped cement outside surface casing to surface. Placed a 10 sx surface plug.  
Plugged well at 2:00PM 9-19-93.  
All plugs set in place with 10# mud ladden fluid.  
Contacted Adam Salameh with BLM before plugging. Obtained approval on setting a retainer instead of a CIBP at 2425'.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
