Confirming telephone conversation between your Mr. Bill Gresett and our Mr. Durham on July 3, 1962. Our records indicate the test for the Strawn Zone was filed on May 31, 1962, but mis-sent to your Hobbs office. We desire to request and extension of time to fill our official GOR test on the Bone Springs and Wolfcamp Zones of subject well.

This request is made due to our current workover beginning June 22, 1962, which resulted from the Strawn Zone dying on June 12, 1962. Subsequently the Bone Springs and Wolfcamp Zones also died and it has been necessary to remove triple equipment to squeeze off the present perforations in an attempt to shut off water production.

As soon as the well is restored to a producing status all tests will be forwarded to you promptly.
