Reference is made to your Notice of Intention to Drill dated September 12, 1960, covering your No. 2 Barbara well in the NE1/4 sec. 29, T. 19 N., R. 31 E., N.M.P.M., Siski County, New Mexico on Lease New Mexico 092240 which contains the "Retain Stipulation".

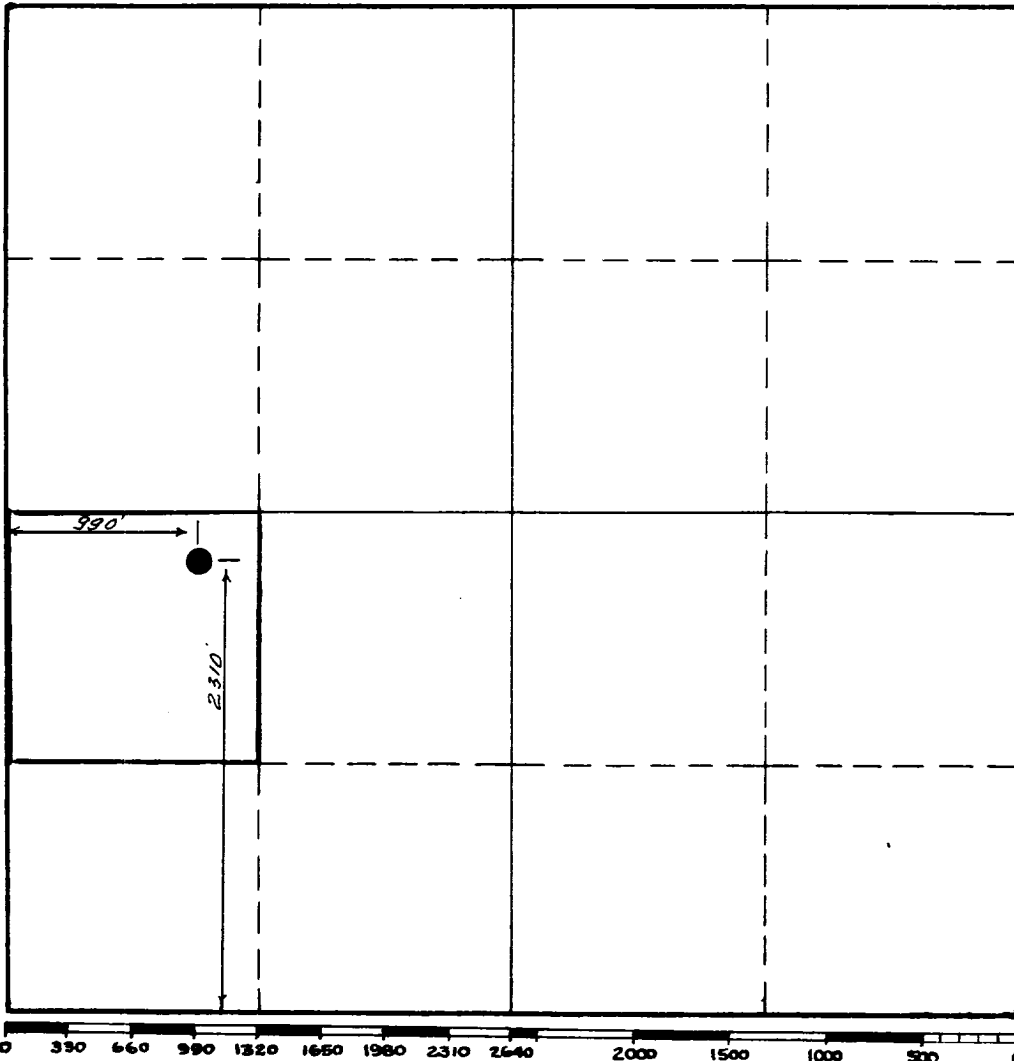
