FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

International-Yates desires to change casing plans from 4 1/2" to 2 7/8" as per Rule 107-e of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rules & Regulations. These rules are complied with as follows:

1. 2 7/8" OD tubing will be set at approximately 1900' cemented with 75 sacks cement with calculated fillup of 225'.
2. This well is not a wildcat. It will be perforated, treated, and completed in the Queen formation.
3. No corrosion or pressure problems exist in the immediate area.
4. This well will not be a dual completion.
5. The substitute for casing will be 2 7/8" OD tubing.

This well was drilled to a total depth of 2593' and no fluid was encountered in the hole in the Queen, Grayburg or San Andres formations. Surface casing, 10 3/4" OD 32.75 lb., was set at 463' and cemented with 75 sacks regular neat cement.
