Gentlemen:

Our records indicate that at the end of April 1966,
your Simon A Lease was over-produced by 5527*
barrels, which is more than five times the daily allowable of 764
barrels, the tolerance provided by the Commission Rules and Regulations. If
these figures do not agree with your records, please let us know immediately.
If the figures are correct, production from the well (s) should be restricted
in such a manner as to eliminate this over-production in the shortest possible
time, thereby, avoiding the necessity of shutting in the well.

No under-production can be carried forward and made up during a subsequent
month, and any over-production must be adjusted by corresponding under-production.
