Maximum circulation 1250 psi. Shut off 1750 psi. Completed 10:40 a.m., 7-5-66. Recirculated casing until plug bumped. Ran temperature survey, indicated top of cement at 1750'. Released rig 7:00 p.m., 7-5-66.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
