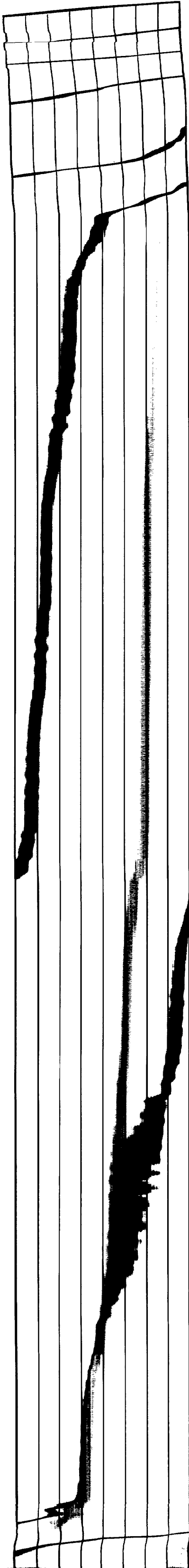


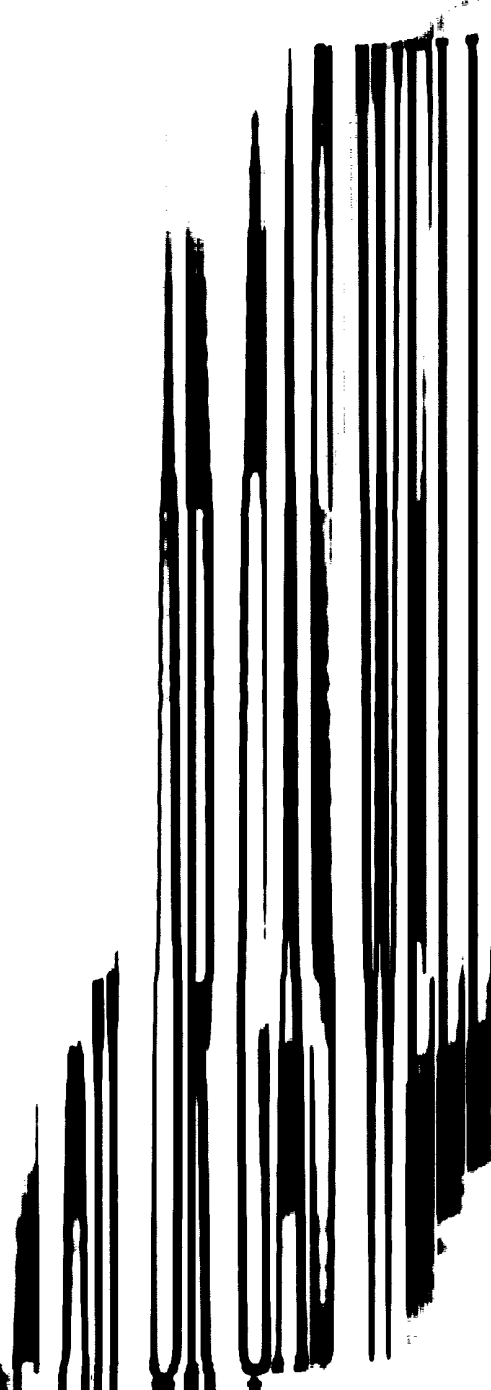

LOG OF OIL

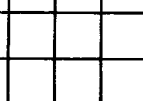
