Spudded 10:00 A.M. July 26, 1968. Drilled 17-1/2" hole to 630'. Ran 21 joints (634.29') 13-3/8", 48#, N-40, ST&C casing set at 630'. Cemented w/400 sx Class "C", w/4% gel, 5# gilsonite per sx, 1/4# cello-flakes per sx, followed w/100 sx Class "C", 2% CaCl. Plug down at 2:30 A.M. Cement circulated. Pressure tested casing to 800 PSI for 30 minutes, held OK. W.O.C. - 18 hours. Started drilling 12-1/4" hole under surface casing at 8:30 P.M. 7/29/68.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
