gallons of 15% HCl acid on bottom. Free treated down casing with 100 barrels of gelled
water and 240 barrels of gel water containing 3% SPG. Flushed with 55 barrels of gel
water. Maximum pressure 3300#, minimum 2400#, ISIP 1700#, after 15 minutes 2000#, AIB
25.5 bpm. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and circulated hole clean to PB at 3465'. Set tubing at
3445'. Scrabbed and placed well on production.
