Frac treated as follows: Pumped 50 barrels of gel water pad. Ppd 119 barrels of gel water containing 1# to 3# SPG. Pressure at 2600#, AIR 23.8 bpm. Dropped 16, 7/8" RCN sealers and pressure increased to 3800#. Pumped 50 barrels of gel water pad. Pumped 119 barrels of gel water. Pressure at 3800#, AIR 13.2 bpm. Flushed with 50 barrels of gel water. ISIP 1800#, after 15 minutes 1200#, Maximum pressure 3900#, minimum 2600#, AIR 16.4 bpm.
