Your application, dated December 27, 1984 for permission to surface commingle and off lease storage of production from the Barbara Federal lease No. NM-1372, Dagger Draw Federal lease No. NM-0559175, Dee state lease, Julie fee lease, and the Dagger Draw fee lease with production from the Ladewick fee lease and stored in facilities to be located in the NE¹₄NW¹₄, sec. 19, T. 19 S., R. 25 E., Eddy County, New Mexico, Ladewick A fee lease is hereby approved. Also your application for permission to surface commingle and off lease storage of production from the Preston Federal lease No. NM-045276, Vicki Federal lease No. NM-045275, and Penny Federal lease No. NM-045274 with production from the Robin Federal lease No. NM-043625 and stored in facilities -to be located in the SE¹₄NW¹₄, sec. 26, T. 20 S., R. 24 E., Eddy County, New Mexico, lease No. NM-043625 is hereby approved.

As a condition of approval, you are required to test each well for a minimum AFEFof twenty-four (24) hours once per month. Any wells or leases proposed to be added to the approved commingling facilities must be approved by the Area Manager in Carlsbad prior to their being included in the facility. Any waterflood operations you contemplate in the future must be conducted pursuant to either an approved lease line agreement or a secondary recovery unit agreement as appropriate.

This approval should not be construed as granting any right-of-way or construction rights not granted by the lease instrument. Such approval must be obtained from the surface managing agencies concerned.
