INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS TO DRILL ONSHORE OIL, GAS, OR GEOTHERMAL STEAM WELLS ON PUBLIC DOMAIN AND ACQUIRED LANDS

Each application for permit to drill must be accompanied by a development plan for surface use which should include information in regard to:

1. Existing roads. *Just north sec. 35, approx. 3/4 mile use*
2. Planned access roads. *Approx. 2500' (See plot #1)*
3. Location of wells. *See plot #1*
4. Lateral roads to wells locations. *Plotted Plot #1*
5. Location of tank batteries and flowlines. *See Plot #2*
6. Locations and types of water supply. *Haul In*
7. Methods for handling waste disposal. *Burn Pit*
8. Location of camps. *None*
9. Location of airstrips. *None*
10. Location layout to include position of the rig, mud tanks, reserve pits, burn pits, pipe racks, etc. *See Plot #2*
11. Plans for restoration of the surface. *clean up & level*
12. Any other information which the Approving Official considers essential to his assessment of the impact on the environment.

The affected Federal and State surface managing agencies shall have access to or, if feasible, may be provided with copies of such development plans.
