Dear Mr. Williams:

This letter is in response to our July 29, 1991 telephone conversation pertaining to the captioned well, recent recompletion involving it, and subsequent form submittals. Enclosed as Attachment #1 is a copy of the Form 3160 (Sundry Notice) that was previously submitted to the BLM and, as of 7/26/91, was still awaiting their approval. It is my understanding from our telephone conversation that this form eliminates the need for a separate State of New Mexico C-103 filing.

We are also submitting a completed C-104 (Attachment #2) to include new data on the recompletion such as detailed perforations and actual production test data.

Also, since this recompletion was more involved from a downhole operational aspect of temporarily abandoning a zone (Morrow "C") and preparing the well for future commingling when formation pressures are nearly equal, I have included the following additional attachments:
