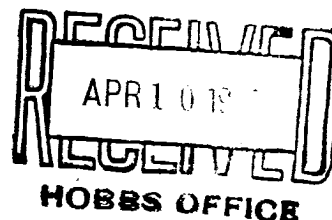

Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3-9-47 Halliburton pumped 40 sacks Trinity Construction Cement to plug 2130' to 2014' and 30 sacks to plug 605' to 550'.

3-10-47 Fourteen sacks of cement was dumped as a surface plug and a 4" marker was extended 4' above the surface.

All spaces between plugs was left full of heavy drilling fluid and no casing was pulled.
