The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Will be personal bond with sureties for the sum of \$1000 or for whatever sum is required by the state regulations.
We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 400 feet.

Additional information: If production is obtained, we will set 6" string above the production, which said string shall be landed or cemented, with or without the use of mud-laden fluid, as conditions may require and the State Geologist or the State Oil & Gas Inspector may direct.
