Dear Mr. Vesely:-

This will advise you that the Dooley-Dixon No. 1 in Sec. 18, Twp. 20 S., R. 27 E., at Globe, New Mexico, is drilled to a depth of 409 feet, with a gas showing at 402 feet.

We temporarily suspended drilling at 409 feet and we are reaming down to about 385 or 386 (386) in the hard, white dolomite, where we plan to reset the inner string of casing and intend to cement same, to get water cut off. While reaming, we have heavily mudded the bottom of the hole, to protect the gas horizon from upper water, until we can run casing and cement same above the gas.

Before, we permanently set the casing, as indicated above, we will file with your office, Notice of Intention on same, for your approval, but I did not want to prepare same, today, as I want to consult the driller, Mr. Dixon, for any suggested changes in same, before filing with you.
