### **DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Cement plug was put in bottom of hole, using 3 sacks of cement, which cemented about 15 ft. of the six-inch hole.

Heavy mud was run from top of the cement plug to 390 ft.

Cement plug was put at 390 ft., using 3 sacks of cement.

Heavy mud was put in hole from top of the plug to top of hole.

Erected regulation marker.

The above was done in accordance with approved intention to plug well during June, 1936.
