Proposed plugging of H. N. Smith-W.W. Simpson No. 1, elev. 3156, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T-21-S, R-27-E, Eddy County, N. Mex. dry hole T.D. 700'

10 sacks of cement to be placed at the bottom of hole (700'), and hole then bridged back up to 370' with mud. 25 sacks of cement to be placed at 370' thru water zone, balance of hole to be filled up with mud. 10 sacks of cement to be placed in top of hole and surface of hole to be covered evenly with excess cement.
