I am very sorry that I missed seeing you on your recent trip to Artesia.

Now, with reference to the Form C-103 report of plugging the above mentioned well, I have a C-103 report of plugging which was submitted by your contractor, Mr. A. M. Brininstool, and was received in this office January 26, 1954.

At that time Mr. Brininstool said he was planning to have some bulldozer work on his lease and he would have the slush pits filled, leveled and all junk cleared from your location at the same time. However, this work had not been done as of June 8, 1954, which was the date of my last inspection trip in that area.

As soon as this work is complete and I am notified, I shall make a final inspection of the location and if same is in order, I will then approve your Form C-103 Report of Final Plugging, and you will then receive a form letter from the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe, which you will sign under a statement requesting cancellation of your one-wall plugging bond. You then return this to the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe and they in turn will notify you and also your surety company of formal cancellation date of the bond.

I would like to suggest that you contact Mr. Brininstool or one of the bulldozer contractors in the Carlsbad area and have them get this location in order.
