

This letter will acknowledge receipt of your Forms C-115, Monthly Report of Production, for the months of February, March and April on your Magnolia-State and Pure-State Leases in Sections 14 and 15, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Magruder-Lates Pool, and also Forms C-104 and C-110 for your Pure-State No. 3 well in the SW/SE, Unit "O", Section 15-21S-27E.

You have filed C-115, Monthly Report, for the month of February for your Pure-State No. 2 well and a Form C-115 for the months of March and April for the Pure-State No. 1 well which has never been completed or an allowable assigned. Could it be that this is an error in well number and the March and April reports are for the No. 2 Pure-State? If so, please file corrected reports.

Now, with regard to your Form C-104, Request for Allowable, and Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil, for your No. 3 Pure-State in the SW/SE, Unit "O", Section 15-21S-27E, I am withholding approval of these forms until such time as you have cemented a production string of casing in this well in compliance with the approval of your Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, which I approved on April 7, 1955, with the following exception: "If surface casing is not used, the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing must be cemented with 35 sacks of cement". When the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " production string has been run and cemented, and a Form C-103, Report of Test of Casing Cementing, has been filed in triplicate with this office, I will approve your Request for Allowable.
