Under date of January 24, 1955, Mr. H. C. Wells visited the Roswell office of the U. S. Geological Survey, and among other things advised that you would probably acidise well #1 and shoot and clean out well #2, both located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  section 23, T. 20 S., R. 28 E., Russell Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

If the remedial work has been completed and the wells put back on production then you should submit Subsequent Reports showing the nature of the work and the results obtained. Lessee's Monthly Reports are due every month regardless of the status of the wells. Forms enclosed for your convenience.

Also enclosed are State forms C-110 which you should complete in quadruplicate and mail to Mr. I. R. Trujillo, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico, so that the Oil Conservation Commission may correct its records accordingly.

Will you please give this matter preferred attention.
