Drill 8 7/8" rotary hole into the top of the Tansill at about 430 feet and mud 7" pipe to shut of surface water and red beds.

Drill 6 1/2 inch hole to top of sand at about 625 feet and cement 5" pipe for production string.

Drill 4 3/4" hole through sand with cable tools to about 670 feet to test sand for oil.

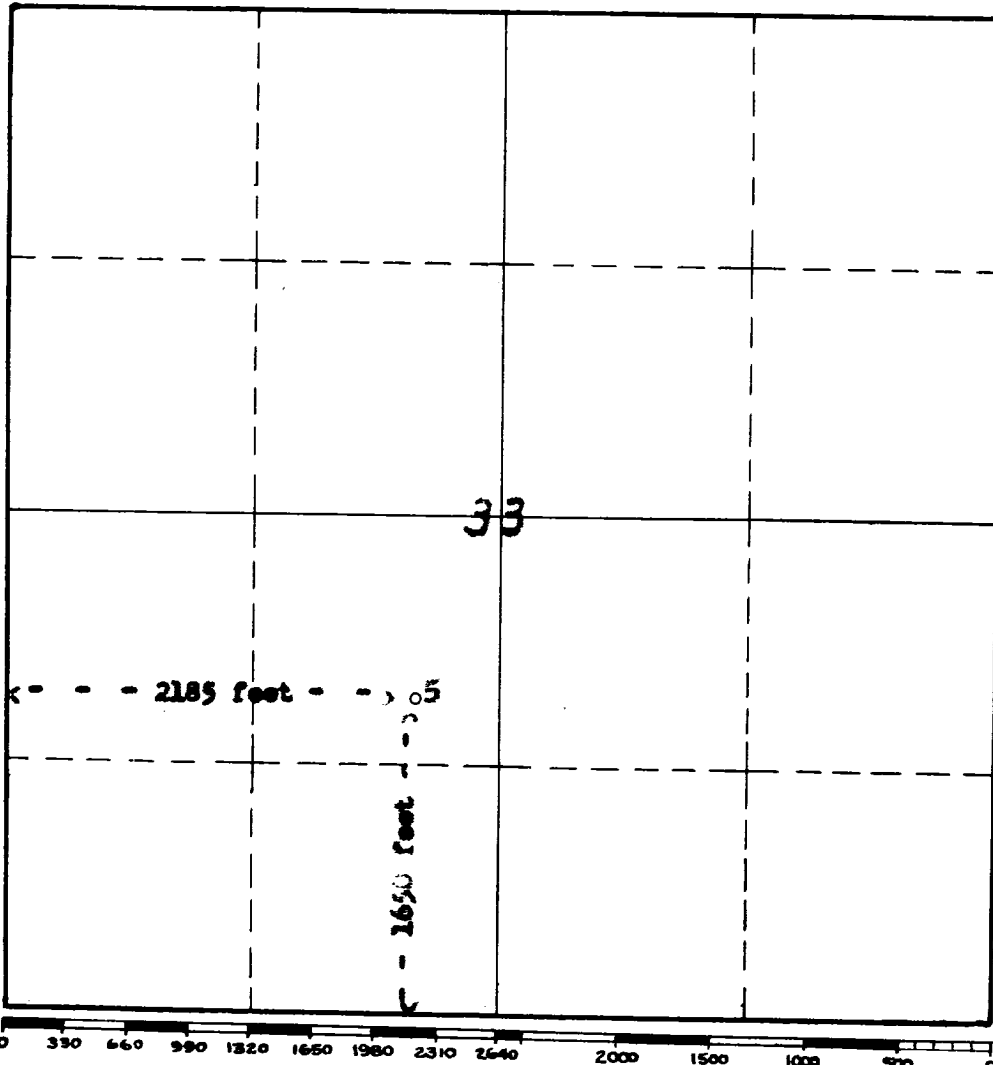
