Dear Sir:

In January, 1959, the proration schedule changed the allowable (33 BPD) on the Getty Oil Company's George Dooley "A" Well No. 11 to Well No. 10, apparently in error. Well No. 10 was NIO and carried no allowable. This has caused No. 11 to be overproduced while the lease remained underproduced.

In April, 1960, Well No. 10 was acidized and put back on production. Form C-104 was filed requesting an allowable of 21 bbls. for No. 10.

Since the proration schedule already carried No. 10 with an allowable of 33 bbls., this was cut to 21 bbls.

We regret that we have been negligent in reporting this error, and would appreciate your restoring allowable of 33 bbls. to No. 11 and 21 bbls. to Well No. 10.
