Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill"
dated June 15, 1937 covering the above subject land in
subject land in 4, Sec. 1, T. 2, R. 2, E. 2, S. 1, on the
you outline details

of proposed work as follows:

"Will mud 1- either 3 1/2" or 4 1/2" at about 100' approx. 450'
with 90 seconds and circulate the mud at about 100' approx. 1580'
with 65 or 70 seconds and circulate the mud at about 100' approx. 1580'
on cement. In case of a leak, the mud will be cleaned up for job
on a 1/2" scale to assure a good seal in the salt water as is usual. Will drill
to about 1500' and will be liable to give with 2 to 3 1/2" of acid if the
formation is tight, and will be liable to give with 2 to 3 1/2" of acid if the
maximum pressure is reached. The mud will be cleaned up to assure
coming we can will not give with 2 to 3 1/2" of acid if the
510' from south to the center of the quarter section.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with
the provisions of Section 2 of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations",
revised November 1, 1936, copy of which will be sent you on request.

Records and written notices relating to these well operations must
be submitted to this office in accordance with Section 5 of said operating
regulations. Any proposed change of detail of the work outlined above
must be submitted to this office on Form 9-331a in triplicate and ap-
proval obtained before such work is commenced.
