Dear Guy:

I have your letter of April 11th regarding the Neil Wills, State 2 A well, Section 19, Township 20 S, Range 30 E.

I am expecting to be in Hobbs the early part of next week, and will discuss this with you. Until I get the log I will not be able to make a decision in regard to using this hole as a sulphur water disposal well. It is common practice in other fields to use wells of this type, particularly for the disposal of salt water. I notice the seven inch casing was cemented at 1487 feet, and the sulphur water is found at 1647 feet. If there is no saturated oil or gas sands between 1487 and 1647 feet, there is no reason why this well cannot be used as requested. However, should there be any oil or gas horizons between these two depths, we will have to make some other arrangement, so we will hold our decision in abeyance until I get over to see you.
