FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Oil well exhausted. Now making 99 1/2% sulphur water. Total depth is 1540 feet. 7", 1437' cemented with 50 sacks; 8 5/8", 410' cemented with 50 sacks. Oil pay, now water, 1439-75'.

It is planned to plug the well as follows; fill up hole with gravel from 1540 to 1430 feet and set a cement plug from 1480' to approximately 1440', which is inside the 7" casing. Bail hole dry. Knock off 7" casing and salvage same. (Theoretically about 750' is salvageable.) Fill hole with cement from 1440' to 390', which is up in the 8 5/8" casing. Knock off 8 5/8" casing and salvage. Fill up hole to surface with mud and erect a marker over location. Clean up grounds around well.
