In reply to your letter of March 19, 1956, in which you request permission to run 373.43 barrels of oil during the month of March which was produced from the above captioned well during the month of February, 1956. You may run the oil during the month of March; however, it will be charged to the March allowable and the production from the well will have to be cut back during March to compensate for the 373.43 barrels. This comes about due to the fact that your Form C-104, Request for Allowable, and Form C-110 arrived in this office on March 2, 1956, after the proration order for February had expired and no allowable could be assigned for February which I mentioned in my letter to you of March 2, 1956.
