We feel of course, that the conditions of said letter have been met except for the required future pressure tests which as stated above have been set up to be conducted.

If you should desire copies of any of the information that has been furnished to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as described above, please advise.

Your records will reflect that on December 13, 1963, Marathon and your office executed a Stipulation amending the above lease form to Form 57 which of course contains a provision for royalty on a shut-in gas well. Marathon Oil Company issued you a check in the amount of \$200.00 on 1/17/64 for the rentals for the period 2/16/64 to 2/16/65. The ten year fixed term of the lease expires February 16, 1964, and it is our understanding that the above shut-in gas well validates and extends the lease beyond its fixed term as provided in said Form 57. Since the well was shut in on January 23, 1964, it is also our understanding that no shut-in gas well royalty is due until February, 1965, under the terms of said Form 57.

We would appreciate it if you would promptly review the matter, and if we should do anything else to qualify the well as a shut-in gas well validly extending the term of this lease, then please advise us immediately.

Your records will reflect that on December 23, 1960, Hanahan and you advised a determination regarding the above lease form to Form 20 which of course contains a provision for royalty on a shut-in gas well. Payment of Company issued you a check in the amount of \$200.00 on 1/15/61 for the rentals for the period 2/15/60 to 2/15/61. The shut-in gas well of the lease expires February 15, 1961, and it is our understanding that the above shut-in gas well royalties and shut-in gas well royalties beyond the lease term as provided in said Form 20. The well was shut in on January 23, 1960. It is also our understanding that the shut-in gas well royalty in the well February, 1961, under the terms of said Form 20.

As this information is of a confidential nature, the matter, and if you should be requiring it to be shut-in gas well royalties, please advise us immediately.
